BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT a majority of the members of the Board of Directors at a lawfully called meeting pursuant to the Texas open meetings law hereby adopts the following resolutions:

SECTION 1. The Board of Directors hereby resolves to approve the Exhibit B compliance information presented by the Superintendent at the public meeting of the Board of Directors held on September 29, 2025, and finds that the MeyerPark Charter is in full compliance with Texas Education Code Sections 11.005 and 28.0022.

SECTION 2. The Superintendent is hereby directed to certify compliance with Texas Education Code Sections 11.005 and 28.0022 by submitting a completed certification form to TEA in the manner and means directed by TEA. The Board of Directors understands that TEA must post the completed certification on the TEA's Internet website.
